# FIELD DISCIPLINE POLICIES



- OLA will arrange the set up “flags” i.e. trackable suspensions – total penalty minutes etc.
- Scores submitted to Mylax
- Game sheet emailed to team contacts (can be restricted by club)
- Game sheet prints out size and format of current OLA game sheet
- Zone schedule can be uploaded into system – changes/ additions can be made by scheduler
- Home team designate can “launch” game sheet from any WIFI location day of game – bench staff arrives to find entire roster on iPad – by default all players show as playing, bench staff then identifies those who are either “sitting out” ( not there) “injured” or “suspended” – system will track suspensions once input by bench staff
- Authorized individual would be able to search and track patterns for individuals and complete history will appear
- Need one Zone stats person rather than one per division – it would be very streamlined to ascertain ratings
- No more late game sheet fines
- No waiting for scores
- No more fines for not submitting roster to convenor
- No more envelopes /labels
- No more stamps
- Saving time & trees!!

# Automatic Discipline Policy Minor Box GM 28 update

Unsportsmanlike Conduct \*

- GM 28 (i) Second offense 3 game suspension and a \$50 fine for players/coaches, trainers second offence will be a 5 game suspension and a \$50 fine, for third offense all levels will be an Automatic OLA Review
- GM 28 (ii) Second offense 5 game suspension and a \$50 fine for players/coaches, trainers second offence will be a 10 game suspension and a \$50 fine, for third offense all levels will be an Automatic OLA Review



Unsportsmanlike behavior is defined as not fair, respectful or polite behavior during sporting events. **GM 28 (i)**

Examples but not limited to: Use of profane or obscene language not directed at any person, continuous critiquing of game calls not directed at the officials

Verbal Abuse is defined as harsh and insulting language directed at a person. **GM 28 (ii)**

Examples but not limited to: Direct use of profanity or obscenity at an official, Direct profanity or obscenity at an opposing player or non-playing personnel, Directing profanity or obscenity at the opposing team

*Sportsmanship is when the participant walks off the floor and you can't tell whether they have won or loss, when he/she carries themselves with pride either way.*
