



Competitive Introduction Clinics (Box/Field Combination 2) – \$390/coach, 7:00pm – 10:00pm & 9:00am – 4:00pm

The Competitive Introduction 2 qualification is the certification required by Lacrosse Canada for coaches at the U15, U17 and U22 rep divisions of minor box lacrosse, as well as the Junior–Senior divisions of both box and field lacrosse. The Community Development Box 1 and Field 1 (or Community Development Combination 1) course is a prerequisite to registering for this level of certification.
