



Community Development Clinics (Women’s Field 1) – \$185/coach, Hybrid Model or In-Person Model

The Community Development 1 qualification is the certification required by Lacrosse Canada for coaches at the U7, U9, U11 and U13 house league and rep divisions of women’s field lacrosse.

For the hybrid clinic option, attendees must register for one online session of their choice, and also one in-person session of their choice.

For the in-person clinic option, attendees must register for the entire in-person session that is offered (9AM - 4PM).
