

TORONTO, ON – April 15th, 2021 – The Ontario Lacrosse Association is currently exploring a partnership pilot with GameSheet Inc. to provide digital game sheet services to interested box and field lacrosse leagues when traditional playing opportunities are considered safe and appropriate. GameSheet Inc. is an Ontario-based digital scoring software system that is designed to reduce the time, effort and cost of managing leagues and scoring games. Please note that, while we are excited to be able to share this announcement with our leagues and clubs, the Ontario Lacrosse Association is not directly or indirectly involved in the application or selection process for this scholarship, and is simply proud to support an organization that is working to improve the data management aspect of the sport by passing this message along to our members.

Timekeepers and scorekeepers are an integral part of every game we play. GameSheet Inc. is pleased to announce the creation of the Scorekeeper Scholarship, which is a one-time award of \$1000 given to four deserving timekeepers and scorekeepers who will be attending their first year of post-secondary education in the fall of 2021. While the staff and supporters of GameSheet Inc. continue to approach the 2021 summer lacrosse season with hope for a return to play, there is a degree of uncertainty over whether many of the major tournaments and events of the typical season will be possible. That said, GameSheet Inc. still feels it is appropriate to move forward by announcing this scholarship opportunity to the sports associations and leagues which it has partnered with.
