U13, U15 AND U17 "A" QUALIFIER DIVISION TEAMS ANNOUNCED FOR 2023 SEASON

TORONTO, ON – June 27th, 2023 – The Ontario Lacrosse Association (OLA, @ontariolacrosse) has announced the teams that will compete in the U13, U15 and U17 "A" Qualifiers divisions for the 2023 season. With over 25 years as a nationally-recognized athlete development program, "A" Qualifiers is the premiere division for youth box lacrosse in Ontario. The 2023 format will feature full round robin play (9 games/team) over the course of two weekends for the top ten teams in each division. The first weekend, July 8-9, will be played at Iroquois Park Sports Complex in Whitby, where each team will play four games, while the second weekend, July 21-23, will be split between Albert McCormick Twin Pad in Kitchener and Woolwich Memorial Centre in Elmira, where each team will play the remaining five games in their division.
