OWBLL'S LONDON THRASHERS SEEKING APPLICATIONS FOR BENCH PERSONNEL

LONDON, ON – January 9th, 2019 – The London Thrashers Lacrosse Club is currently accepting applications for bench personnel. The Thrashers compete in the Ontario Women's Box Lacrosse League (OWBLL) and are searching for positive and encouraging coaches and trainers who are interested in becoming a part of the non-playing bench staff for the 2019 season. All bench staff positions are volunteer opportunities.

Coaches are expected to facilitate practices during the season (typically once per week) and attend all games and tournaments. Additional conditioning sessions may be arranged with the approval of the team manager. Trainers are expected to attend all team functions. Both positions require appropriate training and credentials as outlined by the Ontario Lacrosse Association, as well as a full understanding of the fundamentals of the sport of lacrosse.

Interested candidates may apply individually or as a team no later than Wednesday, February 20th, 2019 by contacting Karie Wells (kariewells@rogers.com). Please note that an interview process will be conducted following the application deadline. When emailing Karie, please provide:

1. A summary of your previous experience as a coach or trainer;
2. Your season plan or goals;
3. Any dates throughout the season that you may not be available (May through August).
