## **TEAM ONTARIO PROGRAM TEMPORARILY PAUSES ALL IN-PERSON ACTIVITIES**

TORONTO, ON – December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – Following the the COVID-19 pandemic briefing this morning by Hon. Lisa MacLeod, Minister of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries, the Team Ontario Lacrosse Program, in consultation with representatives of the Ontario Lacrosse Association, has made the difficult decision to temporarily pause all in-person events until further notice in response to the surge in COVID-19 cases currently reported throughout Ontario and the precautionary concerns that have been raised regarding the Omicron variant.
