The 2022 format will feature full round robin play (9 games/team) over the course of two weekends. The first weekend, July 1-3, will be played at The Aud in Kitchener where each team will play five games, while the second weekend, July 16-17, will be played at Iroquois Park Sports Complex in Whitby where each team will play the remaining four games in their division.
